# Glitter horses



## You need:

scissors • cardboard • colourful glitter • glue • cutting mat

## How it works:

1. Print the pattern below onto the cardboard. Cut it out - if you need a hand, your parents surely won't mind helping.
2. Spread the glue onto one side of the cut out horse - distribute carefully to make sure the glitter stays on.
3. Sprinkle the glitter onto the horse - you can repeat this step. Work on a cutting mat to reuse the glitter falling aside.







# Glitter invitations

birthday invite



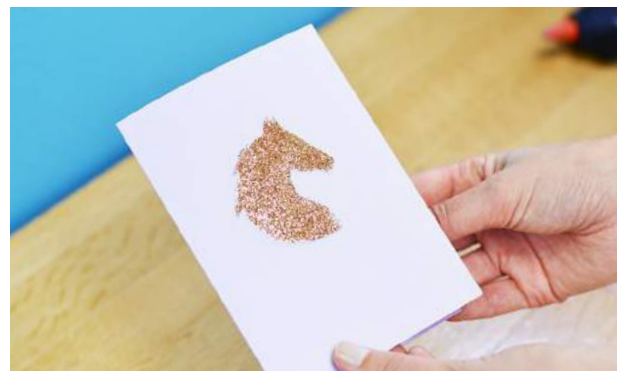
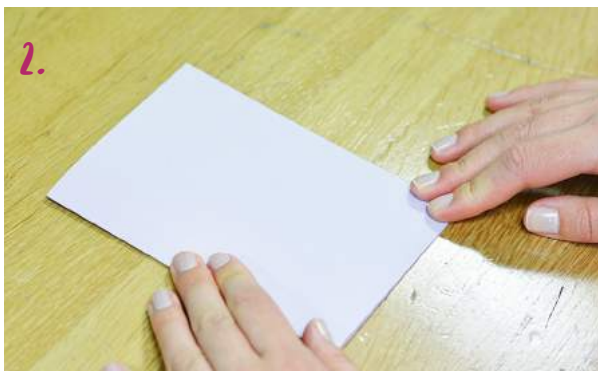
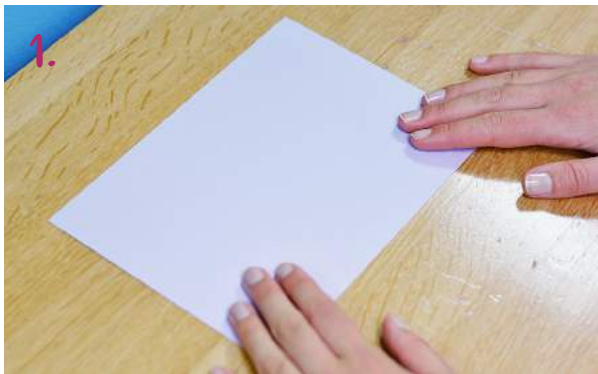
## You need:

cardboard A5 (148 x 210mm) • glitter horses • glue • decoration gems

## How it works:

After having finished the glitter horses, there are various options to use them for decorating.

1. No party without an amazing invite announcing when, where and what time your horsemania party will happen. Fold your sheet one time down the centre.
2. Now ready to adorn your invitation with the incredible glitter horse, placed on the front of your folded sheet. Spread the glue carefully on the entire back of the glitter horse.
3. To your liking you can adorn your card with additional glitter gems.





# Straws and cups

with horses



## You need:

colourful straws • paper cups • glitter horses • hot melt gun

## How it works:

Having finished your glitter horses – you have various options to use them as decoration.

1. A splendid decoration for your paper cups. To attach them securely, use the hot melt gun. Carefully, or with help of an adult, distribute the glue onto the back of your glitter horse.

**CAUTION** This can be very hot – ask for a helping hand.

2. If you like, you can also decorate the straws. Attach one glitter horse on the upper end of your straws.





# Tins with horses

for throwing games



## You need:

3-5 empty tins • decorative sticky tape • glitter horses • hot melt gun

## How it works:

Another option to use your horses – amazing tins for throwing games!

1. Decorate your clean tins with some sticky tape – be creative the wilder the better!
2. For the next step you will need a hand from an adult. Carefully glue the glitter horse onto the tins with your hot melt gun.  
**CAUTION** Hot melt gun and glue will get very hot!
3. See how wonderful they are! This is a favourite game on any fairground. Stack your tins in a pyramid shape. With a ball (tennis ball size) try to knock over as many as possible. Distance from the pyramid at least 2m.



## OUR TIP

It is fun to handcraft the tins together with your guests when partying!





# Garland - pennants

colourful decoration

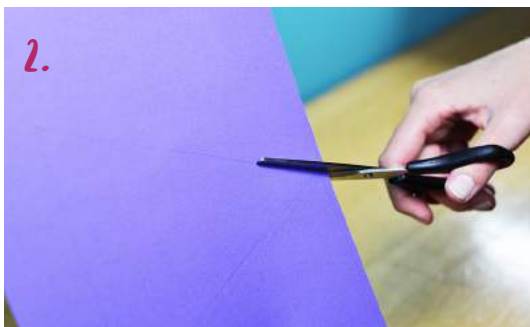


## You need:

crayons • stiff cardboard in your favourite colours • scissors • string to thread together

## How it works:

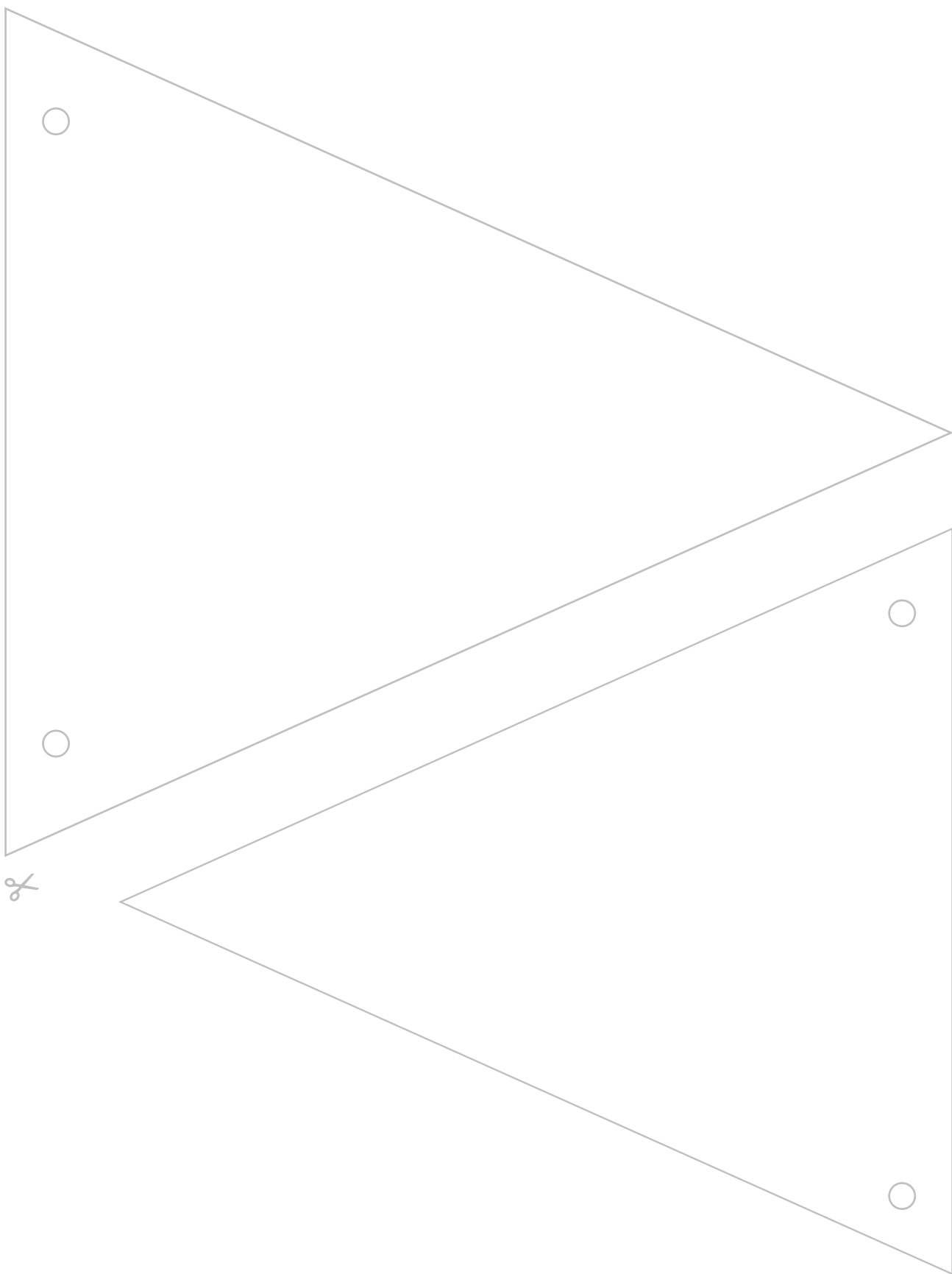
1. Carefully cut out the pattern below – your parents or grandparents will love to give you a hand. To copy as many pennants as needed, just trace the shape with a crayon onto your cardboard. The longer you wish your garland to be, the more pennants you'll need.
2. Now you can cut the copied pennants out of your cardboard sheet – asking for help is absolutely fine. Cut out the holes shown on the pattern. It is easier to use a hole punch.
3. Now you can thread together the pennants (see pictures below). Be creative and decorate them with your glitter horses, glitter gems or make glitter pennants – with glue spread onto them and the glitter sprinkled on.



If you wish to make your garland even more amazing, then see below and combine pennants with tassels.

# Lovely tassels

for garlands & decoration

!!!!

## You need:

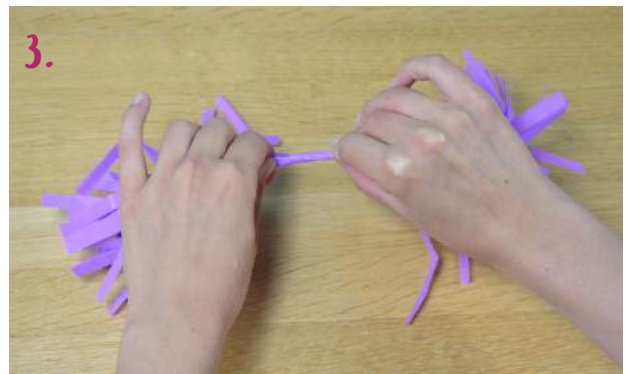
colourful tissue paper • cutter • ruler • cutting mat • string to thread together

## How it works:

1. Fold the tissue paper once down the center. For the next step you're allowed to ask for help. Cut stripes with your cutter, always at the same distance.

**CAUTION** Stop cutting approximately 5cm before you reach the fold.

2. Unfold your paper carefully. Now roll it into a thin roll.
3. Twist the middle part of the roll and bend it down right center. Now twist the two edges together, creating a little hole on the top. This helps to thread together your tassels to create a most amazing garland.





# Potato printing

## for serviettes

### !!!!

#### You need:

stiff serviettes • 1 potato • kitchen knife • acrylic paint • paint brush

#### How it works:

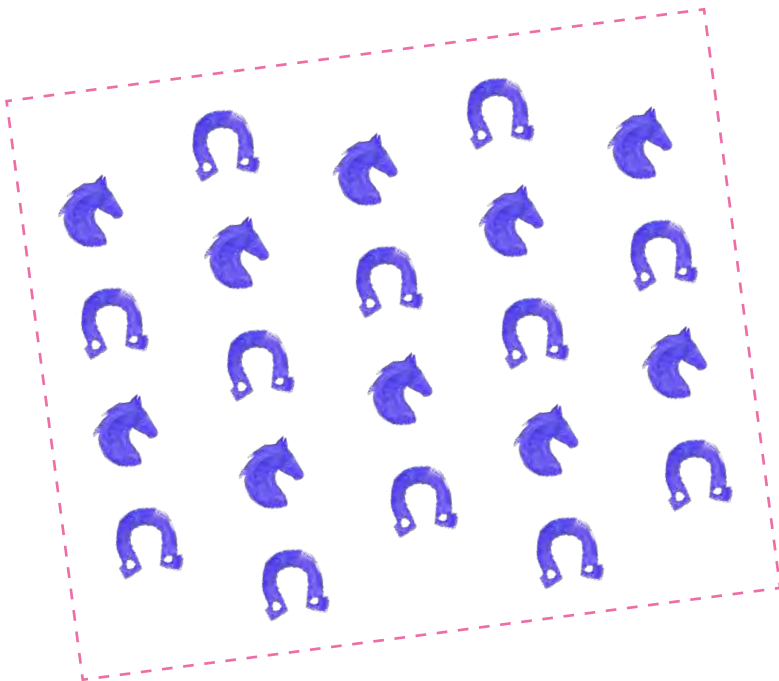
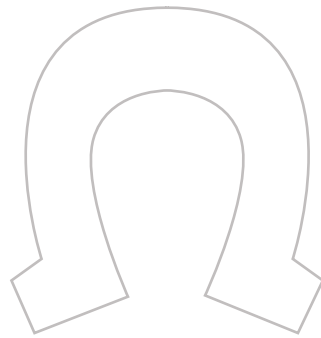
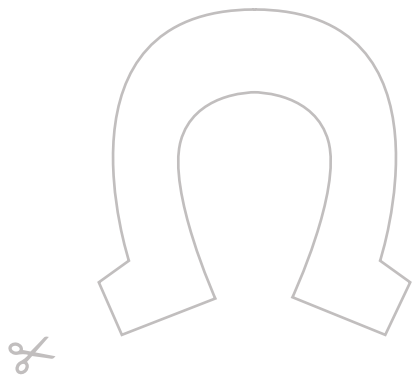
1. Cut out the pattern below. Choose your favourite one, either a horse or a horse shoe. Ask for a hand now. Cut the potato in two halves.
3. Colour your crown stamp with a brush, covering it completely.



2. Place your cut out pattern onto the potato and cut around your chosen shape. The potato is your stamp, so remove the sides of the potato, which do not belong to the shape. Now your shape should stick out of the potato half, just like a stamp.

4. Can't wait to see your first print? Press the coloured potato onto your serviette. Repeat as often as you wish on different positions on your serviette to create a lovely pattern.

# Tournament rosette

to fasten



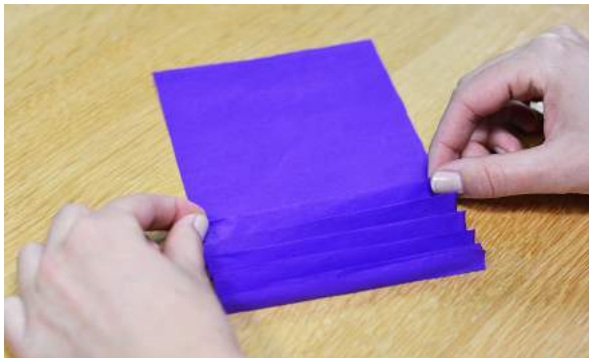
## You need:

cardboard • colourful tissue paper (24 cm x 12 cm) • scissors • glue stick • adhesive tape • ribbon • glitter horses

## Part 1

### How it works:

1. Take your tissue paper and fold it 5mm in the length of the paper. Flip it over and fold it back over this fold as closely to the same size as possible. Continue folding according to style until you reach the end of your tissue paper.
3. Fan out the folds using the fold as the center point of your circle until the ends meet. Use your glue stick to secure the ends together.



2. Take your folded stack of paper, fold it in half and crease it. Tie a piece of adhesive tape around the crease in the middle.



4. Now you cut out a circle using your cardboard paper (app. 7 cm in size). To be continued on the next page!





# Tournament rosette

to fasten



## Part 2

### How it works:

- Tip: You can put a small glass onto the cardboard paper. Draw around it and cut out the circle. This is much faster and easier.
- Cut off a piece of ribbon and fold it down the center into a V-shape. Glue it onto your cardboard circle. Hold it for a little while to really have it fixed.



- Now you turn your circle around and adorn it with a glitter horse. This looks wonderful, doesn't it?



- Nearly done! Glue the cardboard circle onto your tissue paper rosette. Finished!



# Cupcakes with horses

stick decoration

!!!!

## You need:

glitter horses • toothpicks • hot melt gun • yummy cupcakes

## How it works:

1. Let your parents help you with the first step. Glue one of your glitter horses onto the upper edge of the toothpick.  
**CAUTION** Hot melt guns get really hot - ask for help if you are insecure!
2. Now you can stick your glitter horse stick into the cupcake. In the twinkling of an eye your pastries turn into the most amazing eyecatchers.

# Mini-Piñata

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# Mini-Piñata

made from papercups

!!!!

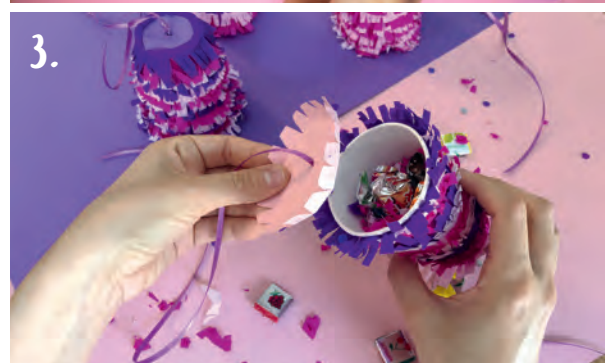
## you need:

paper cups • tissuepaper • stiff cardboard • glue • cutting mat • needle or toothpick • small sweeties

.....

## how it works:

1. Onto your stiff cardboard draw around the opening of your paper cup. Draw another circle in 1cm distance around your circle gained by drawing around the cup opening. Cut along this outer line and cut little spikes ending in length at your inner circle line. Fold your little spikes along your inner circle line and put your circle aside.
2. Cut your satin paper in 5cm wide paper stripes, fold lengthwise and cut little fringes along the open side of your folded tissue paper. Turn your papercup and glue the stripes around the cup. The fringed side directed towards the cup opening. Glue stripe by stripe around your cup until you reached the bottom of your cup. Push a little hole into the center of your cup's bottom using your needle or toothpick. Now thread a ribbon through this created little hole. If you need help ask mum, dad or grandparents whoever is near. The inner edge of your ribbon knot carefully, to fix the cup onto the ribbon thoroughly.
3. Turn your cup with the opening upwards and now you can fill you little pinata with sweets to your liking and fitting the cup. Take the circle with the spikes, which you put aside earlier, and glue it into the opening of your cup with the spikes showing upward to ease the pulling when opening. Let the glue dry - super your pinata is finished - well done!



**our tip:** your pinata can vary in size depending on the cup size you use. If your cups are a little small you can create various pinatas and tie them together. You will get a pinata bunch.
